1) National Beta Scholarships - \$20,000 - 250 Awards (Deadline: January 24, 2019)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be a 12th grade student who is an active National Beta member.
- B) Be planning on attending university or college at an accredited institution during the 2019/2020 school year.

2) Safe Pedestrians Scholarship - \$1,000 - 1 Award (Deadline: January 31, 2019)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be a High school seniors who will be enrolled in college the following semester
- B) Have a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale.

3) Redfin Scholarship - \$2,500 - 2 Awards (Deadline: January 31, 2019)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be a Graduating high school senior or current freshman, sophomore, or junior in college attending an accredited university or college
- B) Have a cumulative, unweighted GPA of 3.5 or above on a 4.0 scale

4) Future Contractors Scholarship - \$750 - 1 Award (Deadline: January 31, 2019)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be a citizens or resident of the United States.
- B) Be a graduating high school senior or are already a currently enrolled college students who is interested in pursuing a career as a contractor.

5) De Novo Scholarship - \$1,000 – 1 Award (Deadline: January 31, 2019)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be at least 13 years old and enrolled or will enroll in a college or university in the US.
- B) Be a legal resident of the U.S. or Puerto Rico.

6) VIP Voice Scholarship - \$5,000 - 1 Award (Deadline: January 31, 2019)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be a United States citizen and currently be enrolled in college or high school
- B) Be at least 13 years of age or older.

7) Society of Manufacturing Engineers Scholarship - \$10,000 - 100 Awards (Deadline: Feb 1, 2019)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be a graduating high school senior, current undergraduate or graduate student who will be enrolling as part-time or full-time undergraduate or graduate student, attending accredited colleges or universities
- B) Have a minimum GPA of 2.0 on a 4.0 scale or 70 on a 100 point (%) scale.

8) Yonkers Honda Driving Memories Scholarship - \$1,000 - 1 Award (Deadline: February 4, 2019)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be a graduating senior in high school or a current freshman, sophomore, or junior in college.
- B) Be between the ages of 16 and 22.

9) HP Scholarship - \$1,000 - 1 Award (Deadline: February 28, 2019)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be a legal resident of the 50 United States and DC
- B) Be 13 years or older at the time of entry

10) Cosmetology Scholarship - \$500 – 1 Award (Deadline: March 1, 2019)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be a graduating high school senior, current undergraduate or graduate student who will be enrolling as part-time or full-time undergraduate or graduate student, attending accredited colleges or universities

11) Information Security Undergraduate Scholarship - \$5,000 – 20 Awards (Deadline: March 1, 2019)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be pursuing, or plan to pursue, a degree with a focus on cybersecurity or information assurance.
- B) GPA must be at least 3.3 on a 4.0 scale

12) Donald and Barbara Mozley Scholarship - \$5,000 - 7 Awards (Deadline: March 15, 2019)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Have a Total SAT score of 1220 or higher and/or an ACT composite score of 27 or above
- B) 3.5 or better for high school applicants

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- B) Work or have been employed at KFC.
